# 2<sup>ND</sup> ANNUAL SPRING TRAINING BASEBALL CLINIC

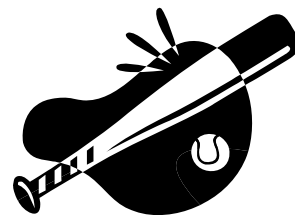
Instructed by staff and members of Escalon Cougar Baseball, this is a half-day program for the beginner and advanced ballplayer.
